

## Moorhead Reopening Safety Guidelines

- Sunday Worship Services will once again begin June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at 10:30am. Sunday school classes are still suspended. An adult class will be added when we can safely do so.
- For anyone uncomfortable rejoining live Worship Services yet; know that we support you, love you, and look forward to seeing you, when YOU have the Peace to attend.
- Everyone should self-check prior to attending church – temperatures, feeling well?, etc.
  - For those feeling ill, or uncomfortable with in-person services, worship “with us” on YouTube at [Moorhead Mennonite](#), and click on a sermon of your choice.
- Our well has been shock treated to guard against bacteria build-up, however, we do not have a drinking fountain; therefore everyone is encouraged to bring your own personal bottle of water, if you need one, which has a tight fitting lid.
- Sanitization of high-touch contact points will take place prior to the June 7<sup>th</sup> service throughout church, including: foyer, Sanctuary, balcony, sound room & restrooms.
- Sanitization of high-touch contact points will take place weekly.
- New soap dispensers will be placed in the restrooms.
- New hand sanitizer dispensers will be placed in the restrooms.
- Disinfecting wipes and/or sprays will be placed in the restrooms as available.
- Hand sanitizer dispensers, in addition to being located in the restrooms, will be available from the greeter and in the back of the Sanctuary.
- Masks are optional, but please wear one if you are more comfortable by doing so.
- Disposable masks and gloves will be available, and located at the back of the Sanctuary.
  - If you prefer a mask, try to remember to bring one from home.
- The greeter will wear a mask and gloves and assist with the front door.
  - The front doors may be propped open, weather permitting.
- Let’s continue to greet each other verbally and with a nod, rather than a handshake.
- An usher will also wear a mask and assist attenders as needed.
- The pastor will also have a mask on, prior to the service.
- If coats or sweaters are needed, they can be placed on the bench beside you.
- Bulletins will not be handed out at the present time.
- Currently, all songs will be projected onto our overhead projector screen.
- Moorhead does not have “Pew Bibles” so please remember to bring yours from home.
- Available seats will be posted by the mailboxes. Additional seating in the balcony can be utilized for a larger family or two.
- We will have a time of sharing and prayer requests, but without a microphone, so please speak loudly for all of us impaired listeners. 😊
- The offering plate will be located at the back of the Sanctuary.
- Attendance will be kept for your safety. Should an attendee (from a service you also attended) become ill, we may need to notify you for contact tracing efforts.
- Everyone can help keep our restrooms safe and sanitized:

- Simply clean anything you touched while visiting the restroom, using the disinfecting wipes and/or disinfecting sprays and paper towels provided in each restroom. Parents, please feel free to assist younger children achieve this goal.
- If you begin feeling ill during the service, have a family member or usher assist you outside, and proceed home or to a health care facility, as needed.
- Fellowship times continue to be temporarily suspended.
- After the service we will dismiss one row at a time similar to a wedding, however, we will begin with the balcony if used, then back rows first moving forward. If anyone needs to use the restroom, please don't feel you need to wait for your row to be dismissed.
  - Congregating inside the building should be avoided but with nice weather – Lord Willing – we can visit at safe distances outside – “Till the cows come home”, if we want to.
